Wording for your Will

If you decide to remember St Vincent's & St George's Association in your Will, you may find it helpful to take this guide with you to your appointment with your professional advisor. They can then use it to incorporate your specific legal instructions (examples below) into your Will.

A general gift – Percentage or specific amount

“I give the sum of £ _____ (or specify percentage of estate) to St Vincent's & St George's Association of Well Close House, Lansdown Parade, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, GL50 2LH (registered charity number 1111403) for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the honorary treasurer or other proper officer of the said St Vincent's & St Georges Association for the time being shall be a full and sufficient discharge for the said legacy.”
