Choosing the type of gift in your will

Your will is your chance to look after the people you love, but if you would like to join us in our mission to continue provide services that allow future generations to live the life they want, regardless of their disability, by leaving us a gift in your Will there are three types of gifts you can leave:

- **A residuary gift** is a percentage of your estate once any specified gifts have been made to friends and family. Many of our supporters choose to leave this type of gift because it does not lose value over time and they can ensure that their loved ones are well-looked after first and foremost.
- **A pecuniary gift** is a specific amount of money. It's worth bearing in mind that the effects of inflation mean that this type of gift is likely to lose value over time and may end up being less than you initially intend.
- **A specific gift** is a gift of a specified item – such as a personal possessions, land, buildings or stocks and shares.



Did you know...

- You can change your mind - your Will is your own personal document so you are free to change it as many times as you wish.

How to make or amend your will

When you come to write or amend your will, we recommend using a solicitor who can help you make sure that your wishes will be followed. You can make sure that your loved ones are looked after as well as leaving a gift to your chosen charity.
